The event took place on November 22, 2014 in the Canton of Petrea Thule.

Duchess Adrielle Kerrec, the event steward, reported that just under 200 folks attend the event, with 81 entrants (including 13 children), 37 sponsors & 68 judges. They offered a day-board which included an assortment of foods throughout the day, and included several items as part of Mahault and Mahhild's culinary arts entry. At times, servers walked with platters among the display tables to ensure that everyone had the opportunity to try out the many delicious foods available. I have to admit that I went back a couple of times to 'retest' a few items.

Nobility was well-represented in the event and set fine examples for all Ealdormereans: His Highness, Prince Steinnar Aggarson, entered his own wonderful embroidery, our own Baroness Gema Krasil'nikova entered two pysanky eggs (see picture below), Baron Grom Meinfret of Septentria entered a leather carved knife sheath, and Baroness Anneke the Furious of Septentria entered a hedeby pouch purse.

Medieval Cooks Corner: by Rohaise de Guildford

Tourteletes in fryture

This recipe is 14th century English. This is my interpretation of the recipe. I assumed that they would have soaked the dried fruit with the spices to soften it. I also baked them instead of frying.

INGREDIENTS:

7oz. package dried Figs
1/4tsp Saffron
1/4c boiling water
1/2-1tsp Powder fort (*I used the recipe above*)
Your favorite pastry dough,
Oil (*if you are frying them*)
Honey



DIRECTIONS: Finely dice the figs as small as possible by hand or purée with a processor; in a small bowl grind saffron. Pour boiling water over saffron and let sit 5minutes. pour saffron and the powder fort spice over figs and mix. Let the mixture stand for a few minutes to soften the figs. Roll out the pastry dough and cut into medium-sized circles. On one pastry circle place a spoonful of figs, then cover with another circle of dough; seal the edges well, *if you are baking cut a slit on top*. Fry the pie(s) in hot oil until lightly browned & crispy; remove from heat and allow to drain or *baked them instead of frying at 350F for 30 minutes*. In a pot, heat the honey. As soon as the pie(s) have drained, brush with melted honey. Eat hot or cold.

Makes approx. 16 - 3" pies.
