From Points West/North of St. Catharines Heading Eastbound on the QEW

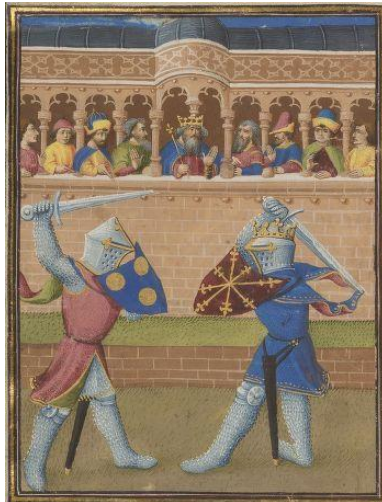
1. EXIT 51 for Regional Rd 34/Seventh St.
2. RIGHT at the first exit on the Roundabout, Regional Road 34 and drive 7.7 km
3. LEFT turn onto St Paul St W., Niagara Regional Road 81 and drive 2.6 km
4. RIGHT turn onto First Street Louth and drive 0.8

km

5. ARRIVE at site on the left. Enter by the south entrance for unloading and checking in at troll. Please park in the North parking lot.

**From Points East/South of St. Catharines
Take your best route to Queen Elizabeth Way
(QEW) heading West to St. Catharines**

1. EXIT 49 (406, Pt. Colborne, 3rd St., Service Rd.) stay to the right for Third Street
2. LEFT turn at Stop Sign (base of exit) to go South on Third St. for 4.3 km
3. LEFT turn onto St. Paul St., W. Regional Road 81
4. RIGHT turn onto First Street Louth and drive 0.8 km
5. ARRIVE at site on the left. Enter by the south entrance for unloading and checking in at troll. Please park in the North parking lot.
