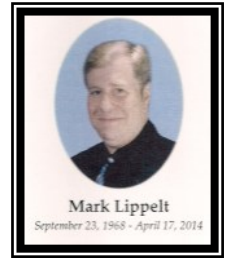

Highlights of the Meetings

March 10, 2014, 3:00, at Baroness Rosalinda's residence. Thirteen attended, plus the cat. The meeting had been scheduled for March 2, but was postponed due mostly to bad weather.

General: The Lincoln & Welland Regiment has approached us about the possibility of helping with their proposed Henry VIII night. Gema will get further details.

Officer reports:

Chronicler: The pertinent information about subscriptions was given to Aibhilin for the Exchequer's Domesday.

Minister of the Horse: Not many people have asked for rides lately, but that may change closer to Coronation. There will be a class on How to Be a Gatekeeper, the date to be determined by mutual availability.

Baron/Baroness: Will be going to Kingdom A&S, and Richard is entering a research paper. Will also be going to Ice Dragon, but will not be able to stay to see Baron Caleb's elevation to Pelican because Her Excellency's opening night for "Annie" is on the same day. Everyone is welcome to go to Their Excellencies' home for a post-rev after Coronation.

Chatelaine: We welcome Ruth to our barony. The next Coffee & Chat night has yet to be scheduled. Despite numerous attempts at correction, the Volunteer of the Year notice is still going to Comtesse Geneviève.

Heavy Weapons At the first fight practice, there were five people; Dmitri & family at the second; and two fighters at the third, but only one sword. There is now a Facebook event page for the fight practices. Please join it if you are interested. There is a possibility that Kyril, a fighter new to our barony, will bring friends with him from Brock University. Now that Simian is of age, he will be getting his armour together. Will there be a practice on April 25, the evening before Coronation? Those from out-of-town might like to participate.

Herald: The Domesday has been submitted. The latest submissions from the barony have been getting favourable commentary. Gema's arms have been re-drawn and will be submitted. Scroll templates were given to the Signet.

Exchequer: The Domesday is not ready yet, but Kingdom Exchequer knows it is coming soon. The older Gatekeeper forms are being deleted, and new ones with the proper NMS amount will be used from now on. An inventory of regalia was done last year; Richard will look for his copy and forward it to Aibhilin. A receipt is needed from the school board for the Alexandra School fight nights.

Historian: The dvd's that Ariadne burned of the baronial picture albums have been found, and are being transferred to the digital picture frame for use at events and demos.

Signet: Some scrolls are in progress. Dmitri is learning calligraphy. Geneviève is willing to calligraph small scrolls. Ysabeau hopes to be able to start doing calligraphy again after Ice Dragon.

Minister of Children: It is hoped that Simian, Beatrix, and Anne can help with children at Coronation. Gema has ideas for a handicraft.

A&S: Fourteen scroll cases were made at the March 8 A&S day. Twelve fighter tabards are needed; is Annabelle buying the heavier twill material?

Seneschal: The Domesday is in. Everyone in the Barony may vote for Baron/Baroness, but the votes of the paid members are counted first. Only if it is really close are the votes of unpaid members tallied. Proof of membership has to be dated before March 29, the date of the Intent to Step Down announcement.

Webminister: Richard has spoken with Othere, and he has tentatively agreed to take on the position, once he finds out what programs he will be working with. The calendar needs immediate updating, so Lady Briend will do that. Ariadne is putting Othere and Briend in contact.

Quartermaster: Reminder about the BBQ/inventory day on May 4; what is everyone bringing to share? More totes may be needed for storage. Ketil the Reluctant is working on finishing the projects in Tancred's workshop.

Events:

Coronation: Examples of the site tokens were passed around to universal admiration. There are eighteen reservations already. Aibhilin and Sciath met with Their Highnesses at Winter War and made a video announcement about the competition for the next Bard of Ealdormere. Arpad Park will not be repaired from the fire in time, so the new site is Winston Churchill Secondary School in St. Catharines. The new information has been sent everywhere. Several teachers at the school are very interested in the SCA, and we hope to welcome them in the near future. There will be dancing with live musicians all afternoon between courts. The Royal Gaming Tourney for this event is Nine-Man Morris; also planned is a scavenger hunt. Her Highness would like bardic performances during feast, but in the background. Can we make silk Highness banners? We still need to find a bartender. We may be able to set up at least the indoor signs the evening before, and we may be able to get in earlier than 9 a.m. for final set-up. Ieuan will be head server. What happened to all our servers' tabards? Will we be able to use the kitchen behind the cafeteria, or just the home-ec room? [no] We will be able to do Thrown Weapons but not archery, unless we get special dispensation from the city by-laws. The local merchants should be made aware of the influx of Scadians.

Library Demo: Has been booked definitely for September 20.

Lady Mary/Investiture: Some of the amounts on the original bid needed to be changed, so the new amounts were voted on and approved. The site tokens and Lady Mary favours are in the works. Ludwig and Misty will be feast stewards. New outdoor signs are being planned. If the weather is too bad to fight outdoors under the giant tent, the basement will be available. Perhaps some massage therapists could be persuaded to come and ply their trade. Yllaria is the merchant liaison, and Rosalinda the A&S co-ordinator.

The meeting closed at 4:35.

Notes by Ariadne

Meeting/Inventory/BBQ potluck, May 4, Baroness Rosalinda's, starting at 11:00

Under the supervision of Ysabeau, everything was counted (with duplicate lists made), re-packed, and re-stowed. Guiseppe is a Tetris wizard. The potluck lunch was taken indoors because of the chilly weather. 15 were in attendance, plus the cat.

Officers:

Seneschal: The amended autocrat's contract was unanimously approved. Make sure to get any forms from the Kingdom website, as they have the current information and values.

Letters of Intent for Baron/Baroness must be in by May 10. One has been submitted. The second date for Meet the Candidates will be a Coffee & Chat night at Fine Grind.

Planning for the Lady Mary Tourney is on schedule; reminder that the library demo is September 20.

Mini-events – To be successful, they need an organizer, someone to get marshals, co-ordinate the potluck, let John the Rude know if he needs to roast a pig, and advertise to Rising Waters, The Hael, and Ealdormere. Ariadne will undertake to do the advertising.

Ysabeau is working on a document outlining Baronial policies, because this is being required by the Society.

Membership – (1) You must be a paid member to vote in the baronial elections. (2) According to the latest postal code list from the BOD, we have 33 active members. *If you consider yourself to be a member of Rising Waters but live outside the designated area, you MUST inform the seneschal of Rising Waters, the seneschal of the barony in which you physically reside, and the Kingdom seneschal IN WRITING. This must be updated every time there is a new seneschal.*

The map – Baronial borders must be contiguous; therefore we are losing Burlington (Pont Y Saeth) and the beach strip formerly referred to as Bifrost to Ben Dunfirth. We may be gaining Binbrook. This has been contentious forever.

Events – The bid for Twelfthnight 2015 has to be in by the July 13 meeting. Our bid for Spring Crown Tourney in 2015 must be in by September 14. The Lady Mary Tourney will have to be in the autumn again.

Gema proposed that we invest in a Keurig for use at events. \$100 voted for this purchase.

Lady Fíne is now our Accessibility Officer. She will work on a database for sites we use, listing problems with stairs, ramps, and washrooms; and running a sign-in table near Troll. Anyone with questions or concerns about accessibility should contact her. (See Baronial Officium page.)

Coronation: The signs were put up outside, although many did not see them. There needed to be more signs indoors because the site was so large. There were some communication problems and a shortage of kitchen help. Having only one key to the elevator was a major drawback to accessibility. Walkie-talkies (Motorola) are the best answer, along with a sign, “Elevator in use by Feast Steward”.

The site cost more than originally stated because the janitor fees were not included by the school board. There was a profit, which will be divided with Kingdom. The lunch counter broke even. In future events with co-autocrats, the specific areas of responsibility for each should be delineated, and a list kept so all will know whom to ask about what.

Given the gluten-free demands, get more cider for the bar.

Having a separate room for the Children’s Corner worked very well. Tristan and Fíne made salt dough and supervised. Such an arrangement could double as a quiet room in the future.

The making of silk banners was presided over by Yllaria and Chiara, and several banners were made, including one in memory of Bracsis which was displayed at head table during feast by Baron Richard.

It is proposed and accepted that the Order of the Dishcloth be declared closed and all remaining awards be distributed as much as possible.

Heavy Weapons: There are usually six fighters at practice. The final indoor practice is May 9, after which there will be fighting at the mini-events at Finally Oaks. Space at a school needs to be booked by August. Alexandra School will be torn down next year. Dmitri is storing the list equipment.

Archery: Gema may have a site for outdoor practice in Welland. Baron Gunther reported the archery scores for Coronation. The stands are really only suitable for indoor use, needing bent rebar to hold them down on soil.

Webminister: The website is being updated for now by Lady Briend Molyneaux, perpetual website deputy and owner of our Yahoo. Baroness Annabelle is willing to take over after step-down.

Exchequer: Cheques for floats need to be arranged at least a meeting in advance to make sure that banks have enough of the right change. A new small cash box has been approved and purchased.

Quartermaster: Now that inventory is complete, people will *have* to sign things out and in.

Herald: The AoA scroll from A.S. 42 was re-presented to Lady Fíne. It still needs repair from the water-blot.

The next big project is a baronial armorial linked to the website and the Order of Precedence.

Signet: Help in making scrolls is always needed. Contact Gema to be put on her list of available scribes/illuminators, and let her know how quickly you can work.

Minister of Children: The games that were made for Twelfthnight will go into the Children’s Corner for use by older children. Several items were found during inventory and added to the Children’s supplies.

Chatelaine: A family who has a cottage in Sherkston may be attending our mini-events.

A&S Minister: Pierogi-making day at the end of May is cancelled.

Baron/Baroness: Thanks to everyone who attended Ice Dragon, Kingdom A&S, and Coronation.

According to the will of the Crown, Richard will be fighting for Annabelle at the upcoming Crown Tourney; therefore they need entourage and someone to run the video camera which Richard normally does.

Richard will be at Aethelmarc War Practice, and wants to field a 10-man team for Murder Melee in June.

The Baron/Baroness, as well as the seneschal, should have a copy of the g-mail passwords.

Many thanks to Lady Ysabeau for her hard work as seneschal and for continuing the baronial policy project. Congratulations to Lord Ieuan ap Gwilym as our new seneschal.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:40.

Ealdormere Waits

To all who pipe, drum, blare, blast, whistle, blow, sing or otherwise fill the air with sound:

With the support of Her Majesty, I wish to announce that I am forming the Ealdormere Waits.

What are waits?

From the Official Website of The International Guild of Town Pipers:

"From medieval times up to the beginning of the 19th century, every British town and city of any note had a band of waits Their duties varied from time to time and place to place, but included playing their instruments through the town at night, waking the townsfolk on dark winter mornings by playing under their windows, welcoming Royal visitors by playing at the town gates, and leading the Mayor's procession on civic occasions....

Waits were provided with salaries, liveries and silver chains of office, bearing the town's arms."

"The instrument most closely associated with Waits is the shawm - so much so that it was also known as the wait-pipe. With shawms, the slide trumpet, and later the sackbut [and coronett].... The majority of Waits could turn their hand to almost any instrument, and they would be expected to play lute, viol, recorders, bagpipes, cittern, hurdy-gurdy, and later fiddle as occasion required. They were also accomplished singers, whether for church music, or

singing ballads and lewd songs in the taverns." <http://www.townwaits.org.uk>

People know me as the one who's always wandering around playing instruments. My goal is to improve the audible ambiance of events by increasing the amount of music, whether it be dance music, fanfares for processions, entertainment for feasts, or bawdy songs in the back corners.

Anyone with any instrument (or not) at any skill level is welcome to join in. We won't be a very polished group -- the Kingdom is too big for us to meet outside of events, and events are too busy for us to spend hours tucked away rehearsing. My ultimate goal is for people to have fun working together to make music.

I have started discussions around passing a badge with the College of Heraldry, and eventually hope to have livery available to pass out any time we play (no promises on the silver chain of office or salaries).

If anyone who is interested could email me, I will create a list and we can start looking at the details of setting up this guild and planning opportunities to play.
