
Marshal Activities: Archery, Thrown Weapons, Armoured Combat (weather permitting)




Directions: From West and north: Take your best route to QEW Niagara bound. Take the Victoria Avenue exit (57), turn right onto to Marina Blvd, then left onto Victoria Ave. From East and US: Take your best route to QEW Toronto bound. Take Victoria Avenue exit (57), turn left onto North Service Road, then the left onto Victoria Ave.

<u>All points</u>: Take Victoria Ave to Eighth Avenue. turn left onto Eighth Ave. After going around a bend Eighth Ave turns into Pelham Road; just stay on it.

Turn right onto Wessel Drive (this is very close to Rockway Falls). Turn left onto Oille St. Turn right into site.

Activities: The Day begins with a processional where every combatant is heralded before the populace and Nobility to announce their inspiration for the day and are presented with a flower to deliver to them.

Also: Archery, Thrown Weapons, Heavy Combat, Fencing, Bardic competitions, A&S displays with personal bests to be chosen by royalty and Nobility. Lots of entertainment, lots of yummy feast with an included sideboard. Pageantry—LOTS of Pageantry. Personal devices are encouraged to be brought and displayed proudly throughout the hall and lists.
