Missive from Her Excellency, Sciath

It seems like it has been an age since we have had the pleasure of gathering as a community together in the same place. In addition to the pandemic, a crisis of race relations and inequality has erupted across the mundane world. As Baroness, I am privileged to serve at the intersection of our diverse community, the Barony of Rising Waters. The events of the past months, and more so, the past

few weeks, have prompted me to reflect on my role as a leader to ensure that members of our community are able to engage in discussion on a regular basis on matters of social importance and impact, and that the full diversity of the Rising Waters and Niagara Community have the opportunity to provide input to and their voices heard by the officers and Baroness. We stand in solidarity with Black and Indigenous communities and People of Colour (BIPOC) against all forms of direct and systemic racism, which have prevented these and other minority communities from participating fully in our community, and having their achievements celebrated and their histories honoured.

To that end, I'd like to thank the Baronial officers for voting in favour of creating a new office, one that focuses on Diversity, Inclusivity, and Equity (DEI). This role

is modelled on the society DEI office, and while not yet established in the Kingdom of Ealdormere, found in other Kingdoms. This officer will be accountable to the people of the Barony, and will be provided with training in mediation and conflict management.

Virtual Celebration of the Barony of Rising Waters

I'd like to thank all who attended the Virtual Celebration, held on May 6, particularly Their Majesties, King Rattanicus and Queen Isobel. This was not just a celebration of the Barony, but of her people - many of whom have continued working as health care and essential services workers or worked to make protective gear.



A Growing Virtual Community

Many, like me, were overjoyed to learn that we would not miss Fruits of our Labour, and that it be available to us in Virtual Edition. Classes, roundtables, moots and meetings filled the weekend - and we even got to have the traditional bardic. Although I truly missed the congeniality of the event-in-person, I appreciate the event staff (and many volunteers and teachers) for giving us an SCA immersive weekend.

Some of our friends from the Kingdom of Avacal attended FooL, and took the lessons learned to the University of Avacal (TUA) event, held June 6-8, 2020. Ealdormere invaded the Kingdom of Avacal - well, virtually, along with 470 participants, attending from 13 kingdoms from across the known world.

Foraging Foods ~ Gelleia le Vinter

Lady Gelleia le Vinter provides us with some tasty quarantine recipes, made including ingredients right from her own backyard!

Canadian Tzatziki

- 1/2 tub of plain balkan style yogurt
- 1/2 cucumber
- 2/3 Tbsp chopped young spruce tips

Shred the cucumber and mix with the yogurt. Put in a strainer and place over a bowl to strain in the fridge an hour before eating.

Suggested pairing: pork souvlaki or dip for fresh veggies.

Tip: Harvest the spruce tips once the young growth is about 2 or 3" long and still bright green. Make sure to only harvest 1/10 of the tips you see since this is how the tree grows! Take them all and the tree won't have enough to grow.



Garlic Mustard Pesto

- 2 cups garlic mustard leaves
- 4 Tbsp olive oil
- 2 Tbsp parmesan cheese

Put leaves in a blender, add oil to make a nice smooth consistency, stir in parmesan cheese by hand.

Suggested serving: steak topper, sandwich spread or with tomatoes on toast.

Tip: Harvest the garlic mustard in late March, early Spring before the garlic mustard flowers as it turns bitter. Also this pesto expires quickly so make only enough for what you can eat in a day.

Weed Salad

Dandelion and plantain leaves, I choose the ones growing in the shade since they tend to be tender and less bitter. Give them a quick wash and chop like a normal salad, add cucumber and tomatoes. Top with a quick miso salad dressing.

Miso Salad Dressing

- 1 Tbsp miso paste
- 2 Tbsp olive oil
- salt, pepper, and fresh oregano

Put leaves in a blender, add oil to make a nice smooth consistency, stir in parmesan cheese by hand.

Suggested serving: steak topper, sandwich spread or with tomatoes on toast.



In case you aren't sure... this is plantain!

Tip: Harvest the garlic mustard in late March, early Spring before the garlic mustard flowers as it turns bitter. Also this pesto expires quickly so make only enough for what you can eat in a day.


Greetings from the Signet






Round one of the Scribal War is over, but the final results for the kingdoms are still being tallied but our artists managed to win in a couple of categories!
