The recipient is gifted with a 'golden' chalice, but not before a liquid (the nature of which is an order secret) is poured into it and shared among the order. We are thrilled that the order has unanimously agreed to admit Noble Rhys of Anglesey into the Order of the Gold Chalice this year. Wassail!

#### **Baronial Succession 2025**

May 4, 2025

Greetings, yesterday during Court at Lady Mary, Their Royal Majesties gave permission to Her Excellency Baroness Sciath ingen Chaennaig to retire from the Baronial seat of Rising Waters. Thus begins the election process for the next gentle(s) to sit the seat(s). The timeline agreed upon at this time is as follows:

May 3: Her Excellency announced Her retirement at the Lady Mary Memorial Tournament, and invited prospective candidates to submit their intention to stand in the election process.

June 2: Last day for letters of intent to be submitted as per the policy.

June 3: Candidates' names and letters of intent will be submitted to Their Majesties, Their Highnesses and Kingdom Seneschal for review and acceptance.

Once the candidates are approved, we will inform the candidates and plan meetings for the Baronial populace to meet with the candidates. The exact dates will be confirmed, once the candidates are approved. Tentatively, these meetings will be for:

June 11-13: Meet the candidates meeting at a fight practice (TB Scheduled, currently Thursdays). June 14: Second meet the candidates opportunity.

#### It's the Season for Battle

May 15, 2025

We have received information about Murder Melee in the Meadow XL, scheduled for June 5-8, 2025 at the Germania Park Campgrounds in Binbrook.

Armoured Combat: For new fighters, authorizations are scheduled for Friday at 6:30 followed by a Novice Tournament. Anyone authorized three years or less and have never won a tournament are welcome to enter the Novice Tournament! Armoured Combat authorizations is also scheduled for Saturday at 1130, and at noon there will be a round robin 5-fighter melee tournament. I call on our fighters in Rising Waters to assemble and be counted in this tournament! After the 5-fighter melee tournament, there will be a round robin 10-fighter tournament. Teams of 5 from earlier are welcome to pair up any way they like, and duct tape of many colours will be available to mark helms to avoid any confusion on who to hit with a stick. After that there will be Grand Melees.... Fight until you can't any more!

**Rapier Combat:** Fencing will begin on Saturday at 10am with authorizations. A tournament of 10 on 10 begins at 11am, in a best of three battle. In the afternoon, the Ealdormere Academy of Defence (EAOD) will hold defense trials for those challenging prizes. Finally – pending confirmation – Master Giovanni de Enzinasis teaching a Harnessfecten Class – learn to fight in armour with spear, sword and dagger.

Rest assured, there will be plenty of time for **Archery** and **Thrown Weapons!** 

The gate opens on Thursday night at 6pm for those wishing to stay for the whole event. Rising Waters will be there!

#### **Armoured Combat and Fencing**

Armoured Combat and Fencing practices move indoors over the cooler months, and shift back outside in the Spring. We have had a very strong showing for fencing practice over the past few months, with interest in cut and thrust fencing. The school we used for practices may see us return, since its location in Grimsby meant that many of our friends in the Barony of Ben Dunfirth could join us in our martial practices.













'Tis the Season of the Axe, Knife and Spear

As soon as the snow melts, and the sun lights up the sky in the evening, the Baronial thrown weapons practice range is open. Between May 7 and July 2, the practice range for thrown weapons has been open eight times, and welcomed between 3 to 7 throwers each week. If you've never been to a practice, let me tell you about what happens. Participants arrive, and marshals inspect their weapons to ensure that they are safe to throw. Marshals go through the rules of the range for participants. If you are not a member of the SCA, you will need to sign a waiver for the practice.

The first part of a practice consists of warm-up throws. Marshals in training set up the range with targets at 10 feet and 20 feet, in two lanes. We spend 30-45 minutes with warm-ups (knives, axes, and spear), then another 30-45 minutes going through a Royal Rounds Tournament, or another entertaining tournament concocted by one of the marshals. Finally, we are also participating in the society TW experiment to test out spear throwing at 15 feet, reporting on throws with hard and soft targets and any bounce-backs. We have had well-over three hundred spear throws, with an excellent safety record. So far, this Summer has been an amazing time on the range. Just look at all of these pictures of happy throwers!



This year, we have had two new marshals qualify, Ciarnan Gunn of Rising Waters and Lord Jotun-Bjorn. Congratulations to both of you!
