
Armoured Marshal's Report (Andrew/Richard)

- Barony of Rising Waters Marshal's Report Armour
- There have been two armour combat practices since our last meeting. Two were cancelled due to a lack of fighters with one being busy with work or away and another with an injury. The upcoming March 18 practice is cancelled due to March break.
- Lord Fulk has attended one practice and plans to fix his armour and start fighting again. Victoria, a brand new fighter, has been outfitted in some loaner armour by Sir Richard. So we can grow from three to five regular fighters at our practice. Sir Richard has two loaner kits from Lord Michaelus for a average to large man if we get any new fighters of that size.
