Event Report: FOOL XIV


Another successful FOOL has come and gone. Most of the round tables were well attended and informative/helpful, and on the whole participants have had positive things to share about the experience this year.

Remember When...

Many of Septentria's awards date back to near the founding of the Barony. For example, the Bear's Claw (the first award to be attached to Septentria) was registered in 1986, and the Order of the Cauldron was registered in 1987. However, the Golden Bear - the award given for excellence in the Arts and Sciences - came much later at the Barony's 25th anniversary (A.S. 38). Their Excellencies Corwyn and Domhnail Galbraith instituted it, and the first recipient was Lady Wencendl inginea Jagomus of Rokesburg. Hers was carved from golden amber, whereas future editions were made from brass.

TAXES !



Bonguard Problem


On the left are 6 instances of the rule being followed. On the right are 6 instances of the rule being contravened. What is the rule?




















