

## **Arsine** Adventures



Meet Ursa, a little polar bear who has just been born in the BEARony. She has much to see and learn and do as a young cub, and so shall accompany me on my travels throughout the Realm. Here she is at the Baronial Investiture. There are two kinds of Barons and Baronesses: landed and court. Landed Barons and Baronesses wear golden coronets, and hold land (called a Barony) for the Crown of their Kingdom. They advise the Royal family as to the state of the Barony during their Reigns and can conduct their own Courts at various events. Court Barons and Baronesses wear silver coronets, and do not Reign over any land and do not hold their own Courts. Court Barons and Baronesses are granted said status by the Crown, usually for extended exemplary service to Them. It is common in Ealdormere that landed Barons and Baronesses be granted the status of court Barons and Baronesses after their Reign ends. The honorific accorded to all of them is 'Your Excellency'.
