

A milder version of Forme of Curry recipe.

Take Mustard seed and waishe it & drye it in an ovene, grynde it drye. farse it thurgh a farse. clarifie hony with wyne & vynegur & stere it wel togedrer and make it thikke ynowz. & whan ou wilt spende erof make it tnynne with wyne.

I have finally found the proper mix of mustard seeds spicy enough and mellow enough that when ground together in my large period stone mortar and pestle give the most excellent base for this Mediaeval honey mustard.

Ingredients: select black and yellow mustard seeds, white vinegar, honey.


