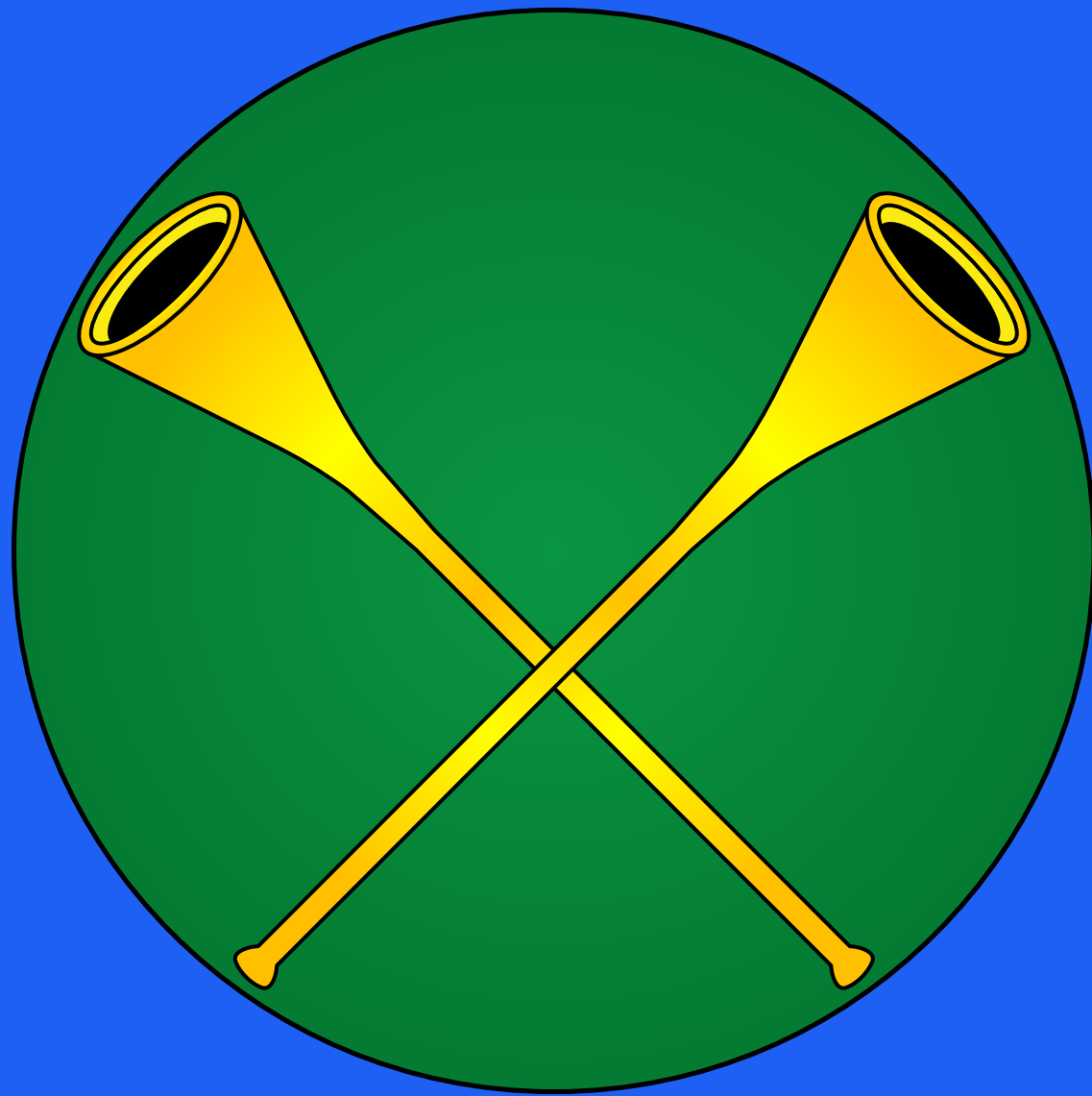

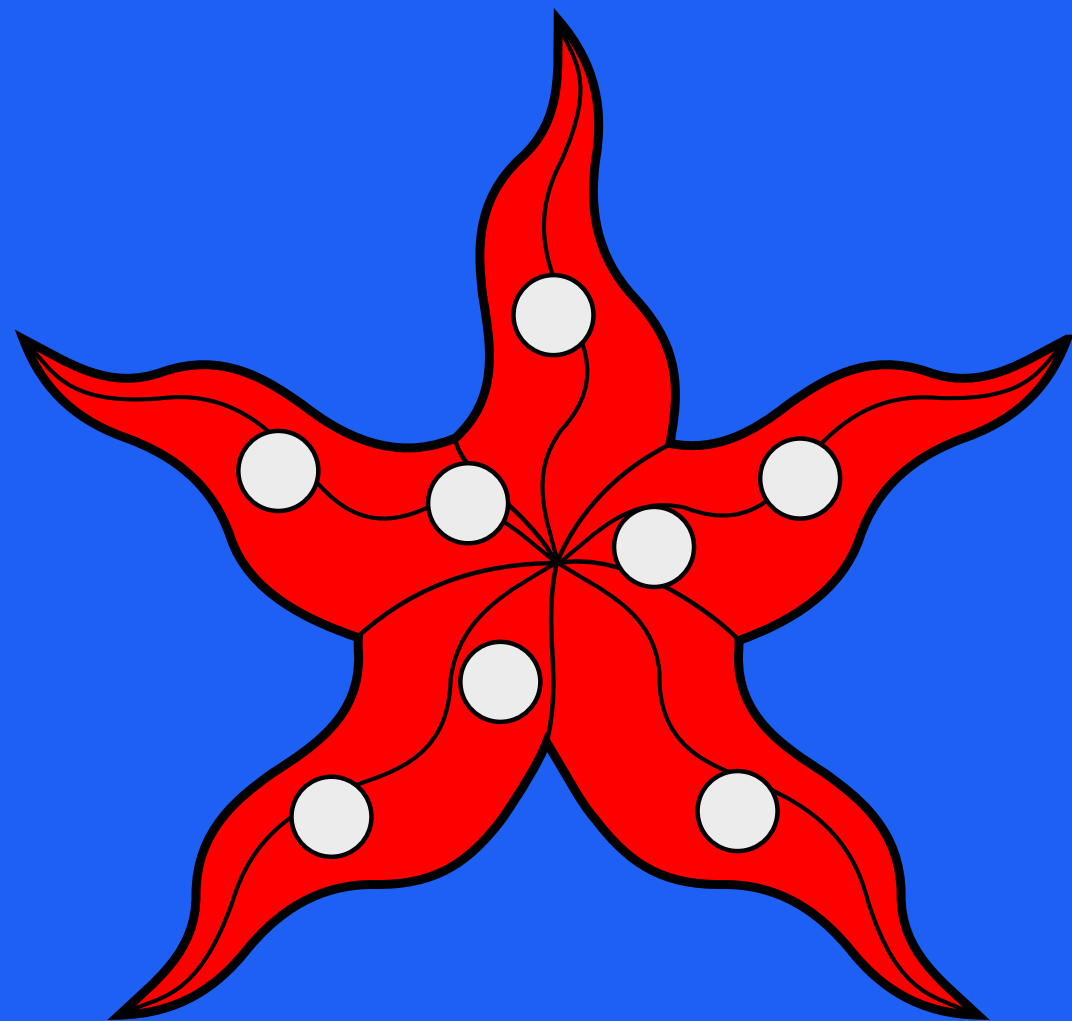
Basic Inkscape Tour 1

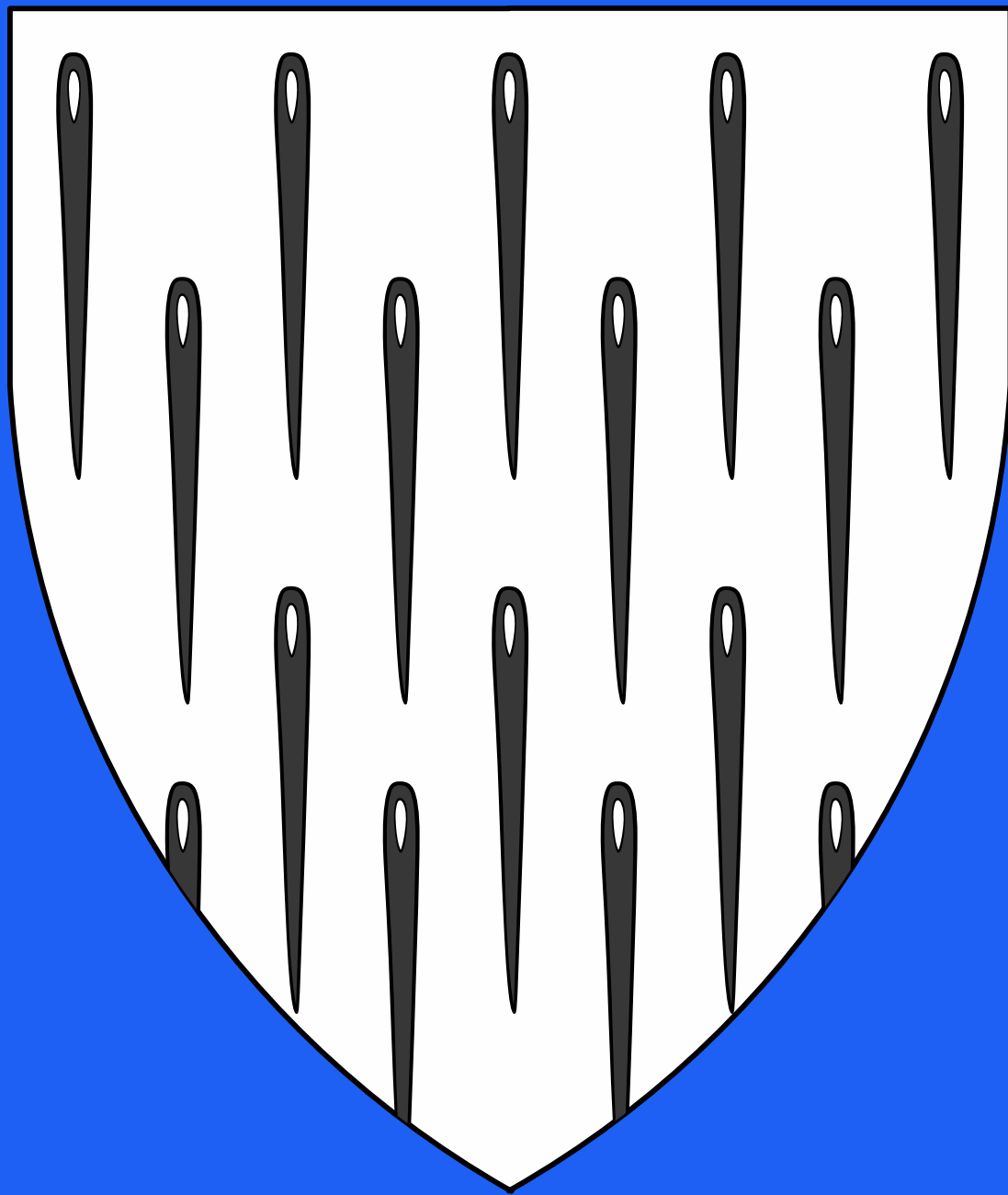

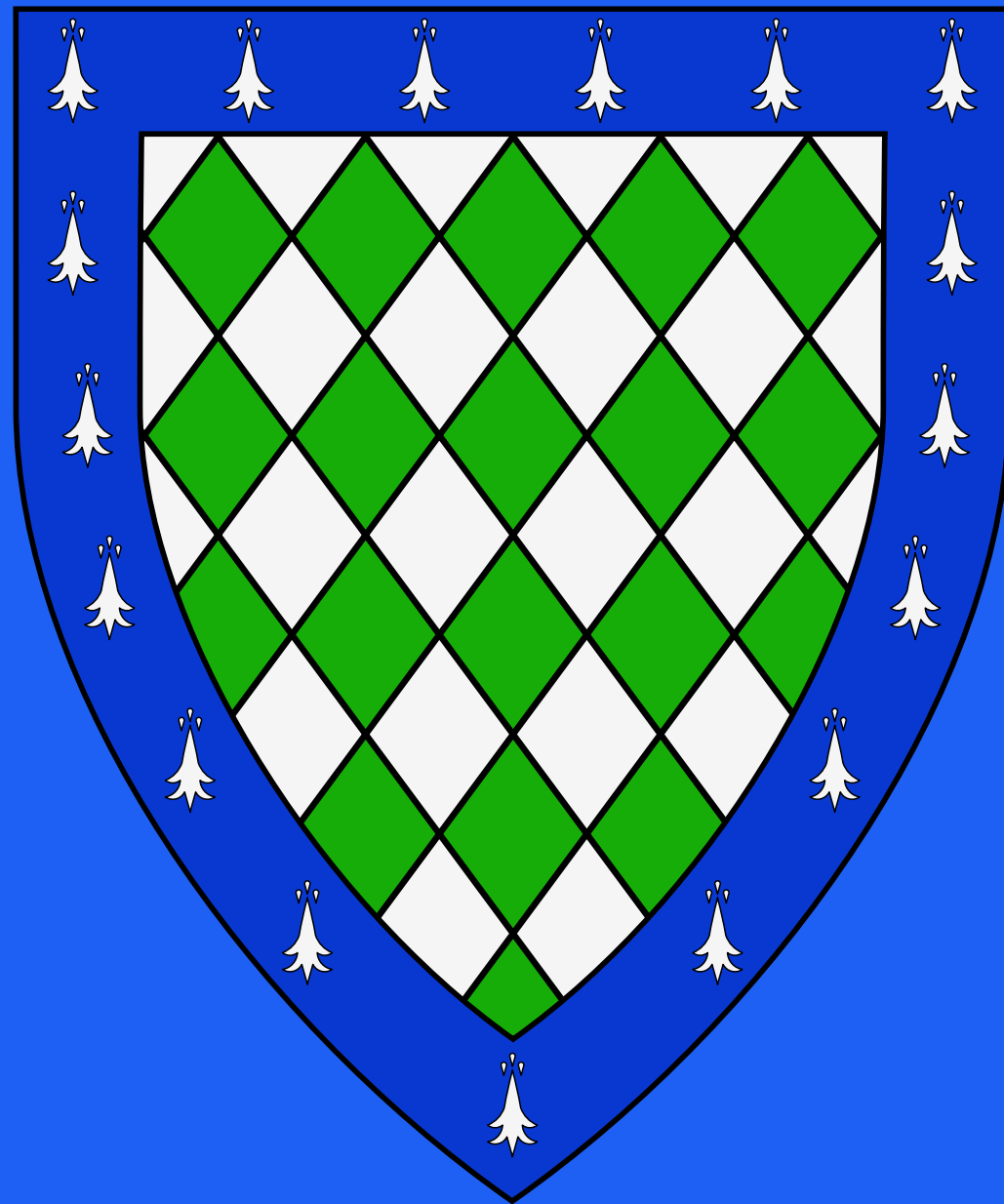

Export as PNG / File-Export, button on right, or Ctrl+Shift+E



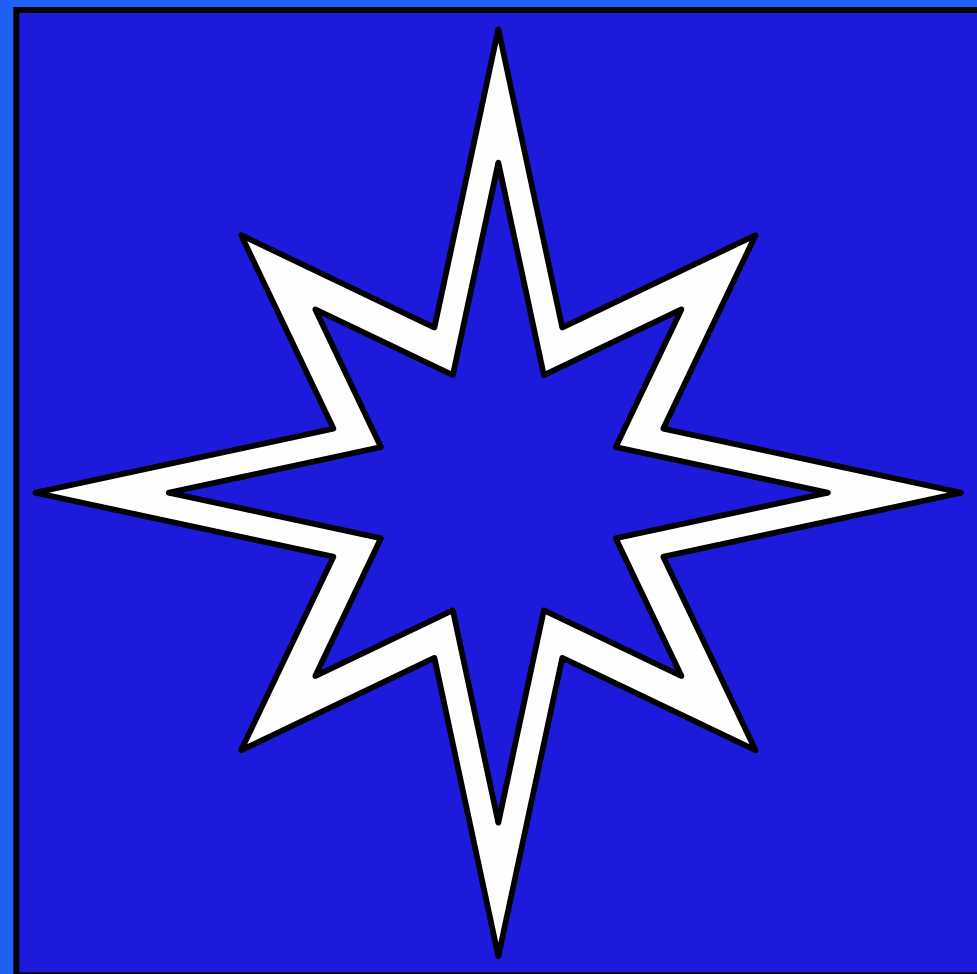

Function keys - fast tool switching

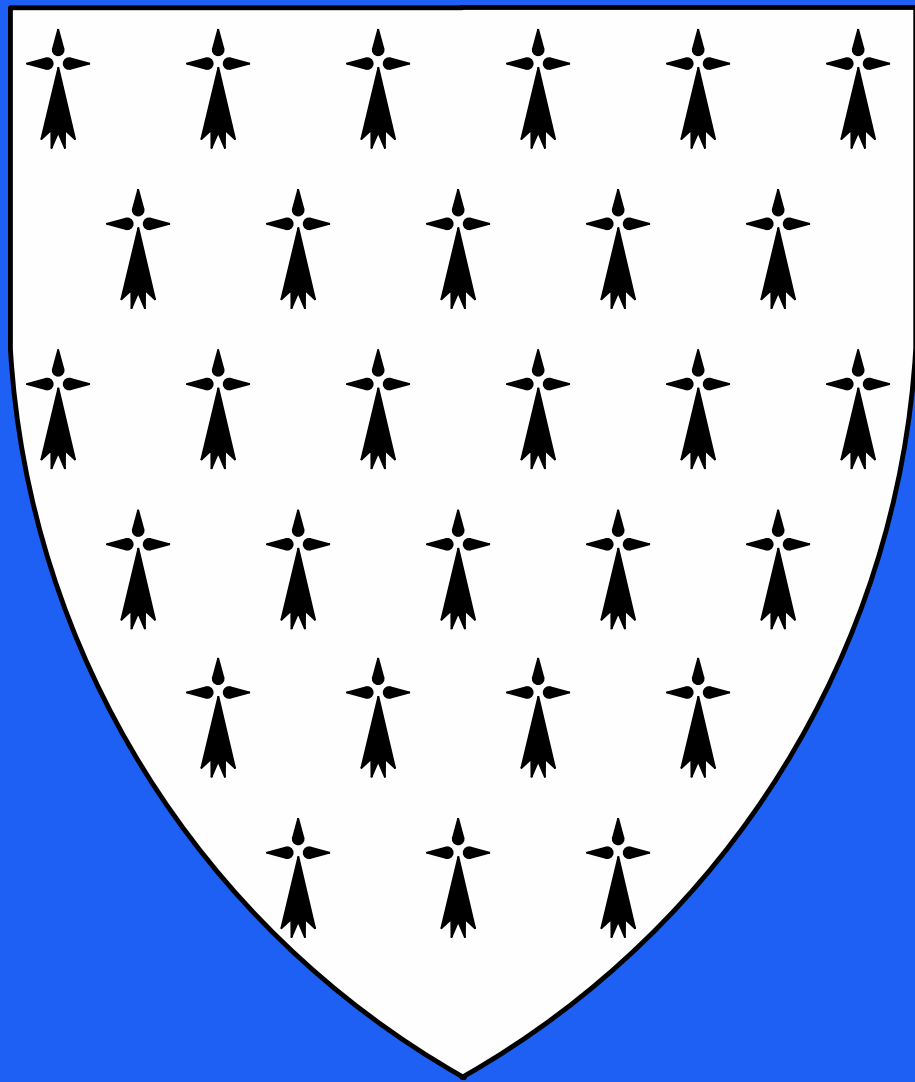

fill, etc



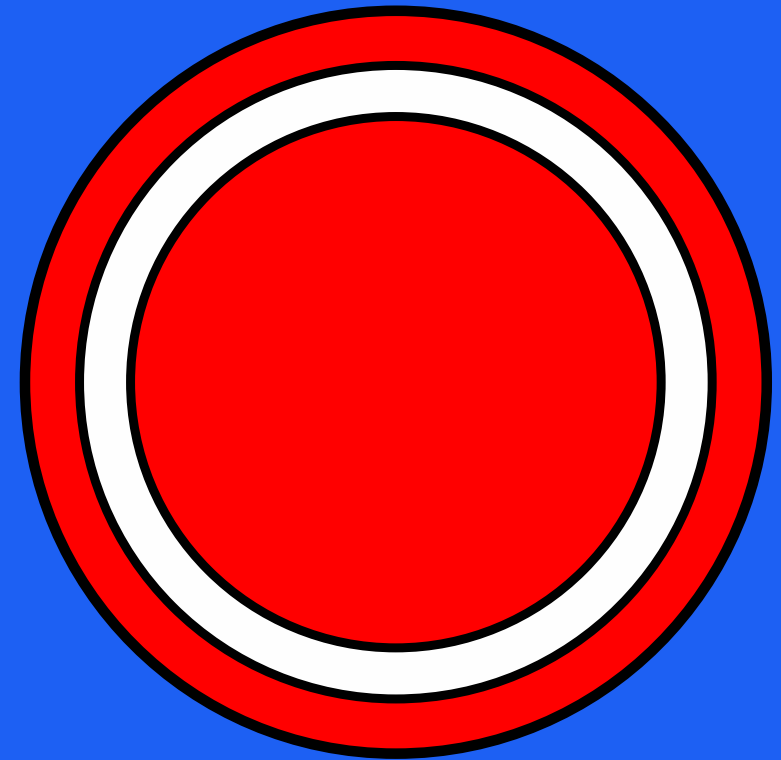

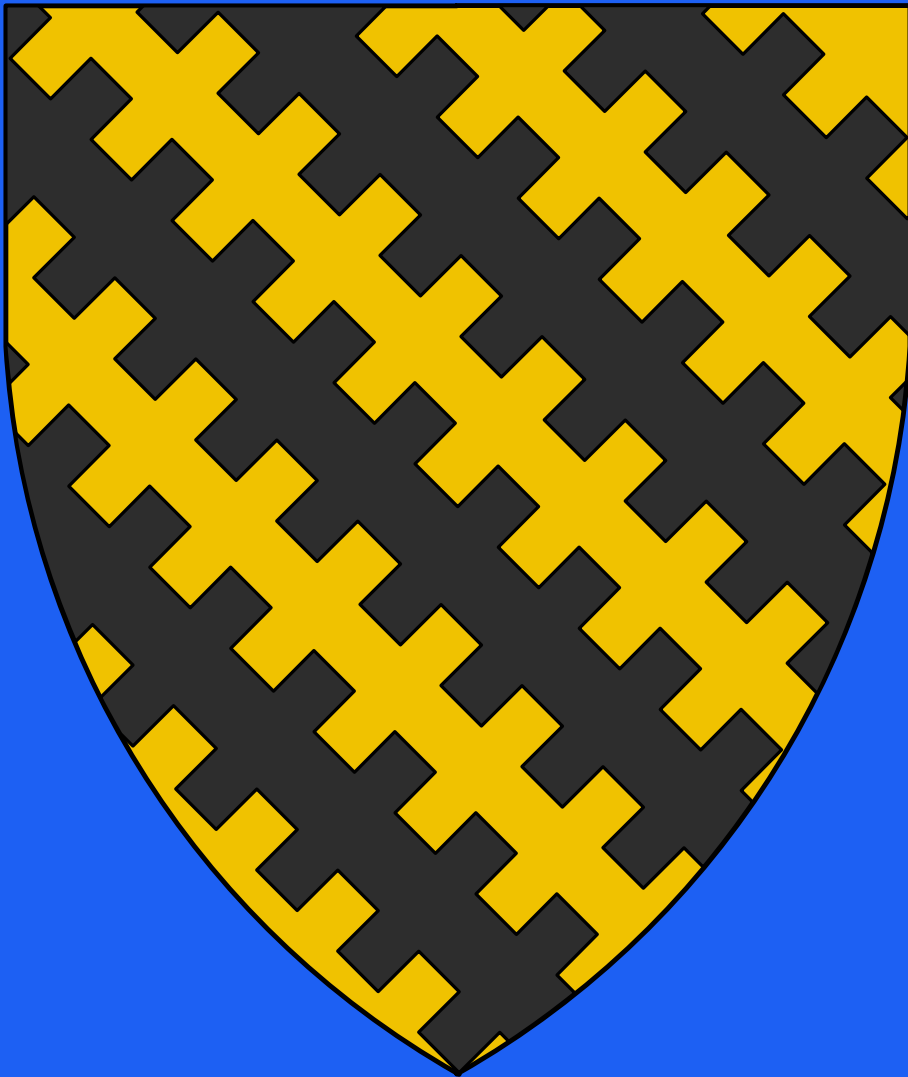
Path menu / Boolean

& orles.





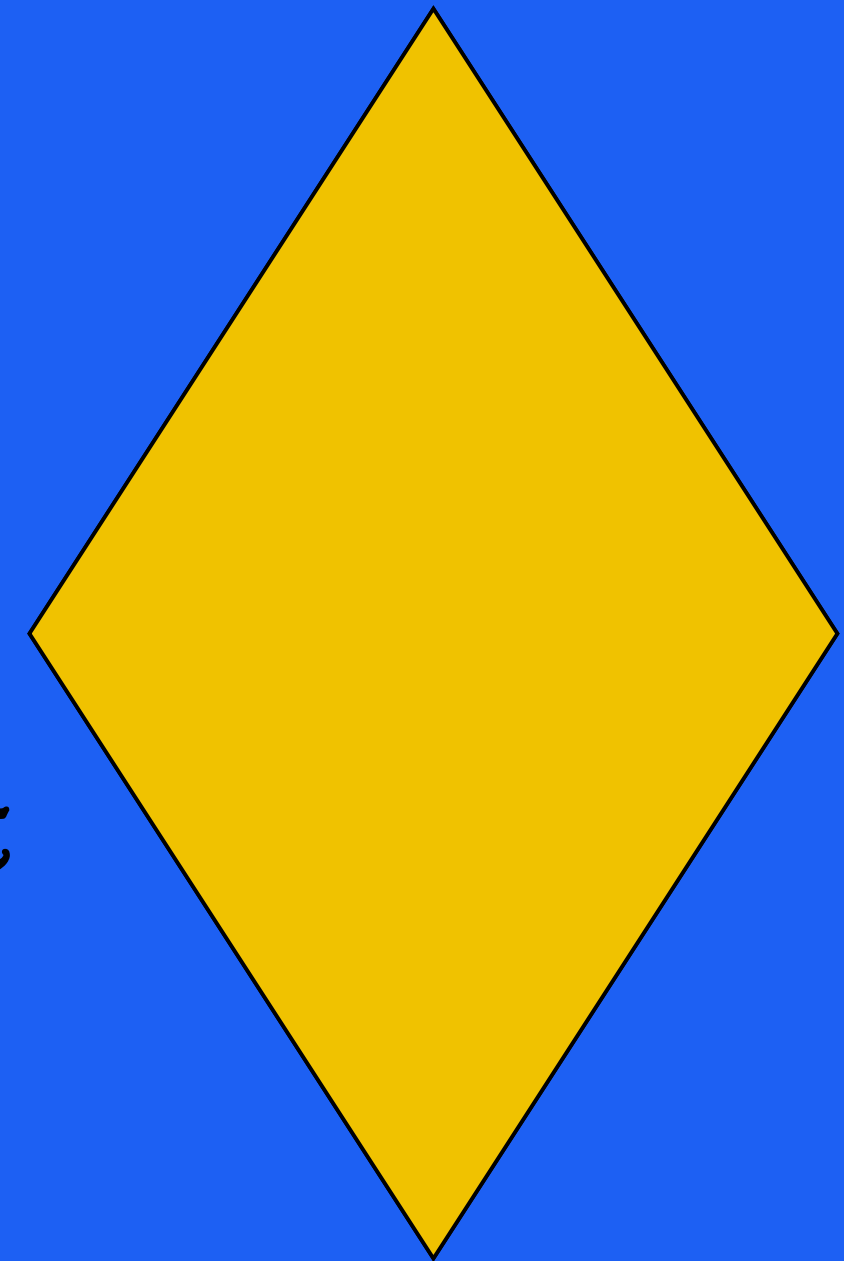
Boolean Operations 2

Used for fine detail tweaking.

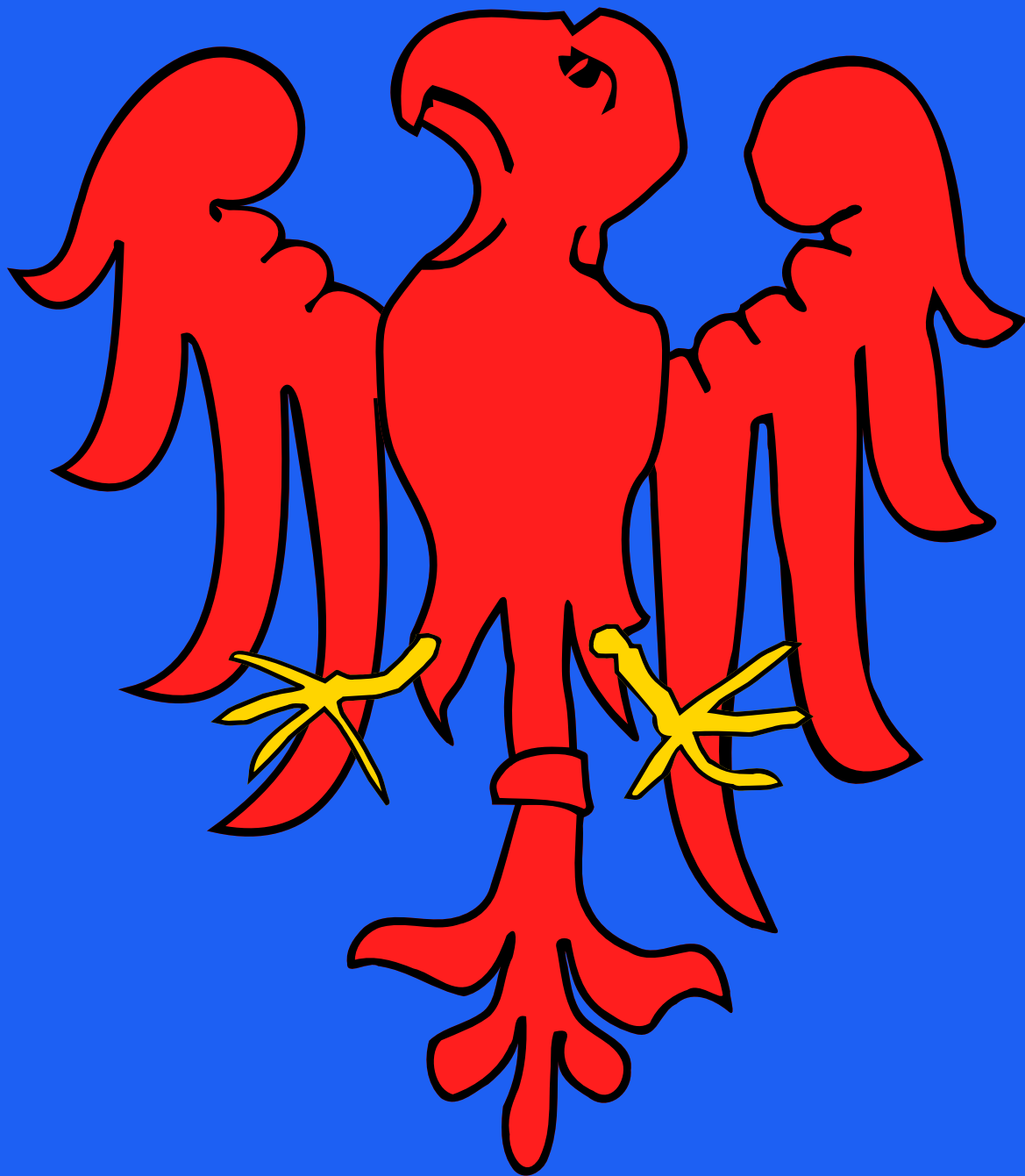
Removing parts of an SVG.

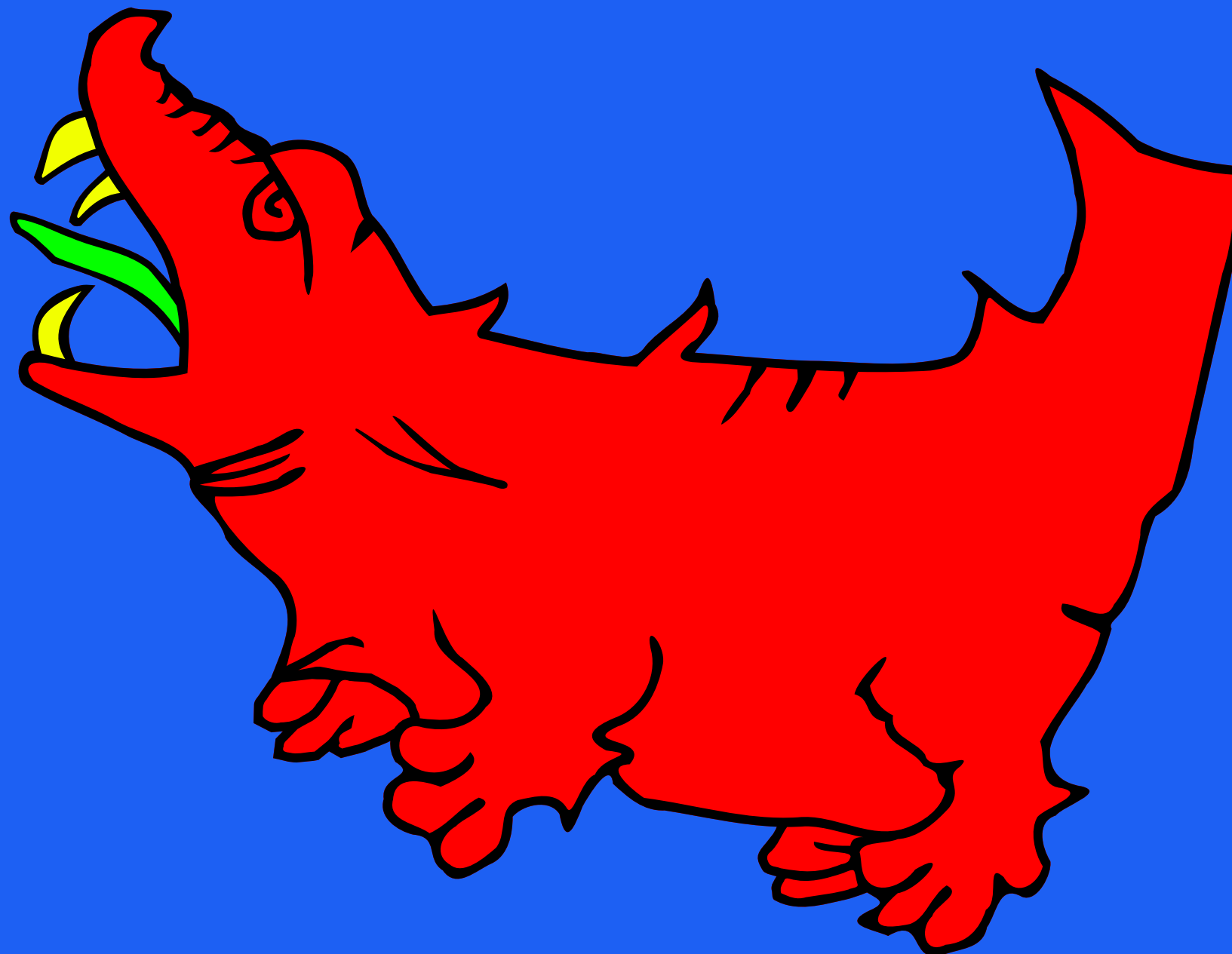

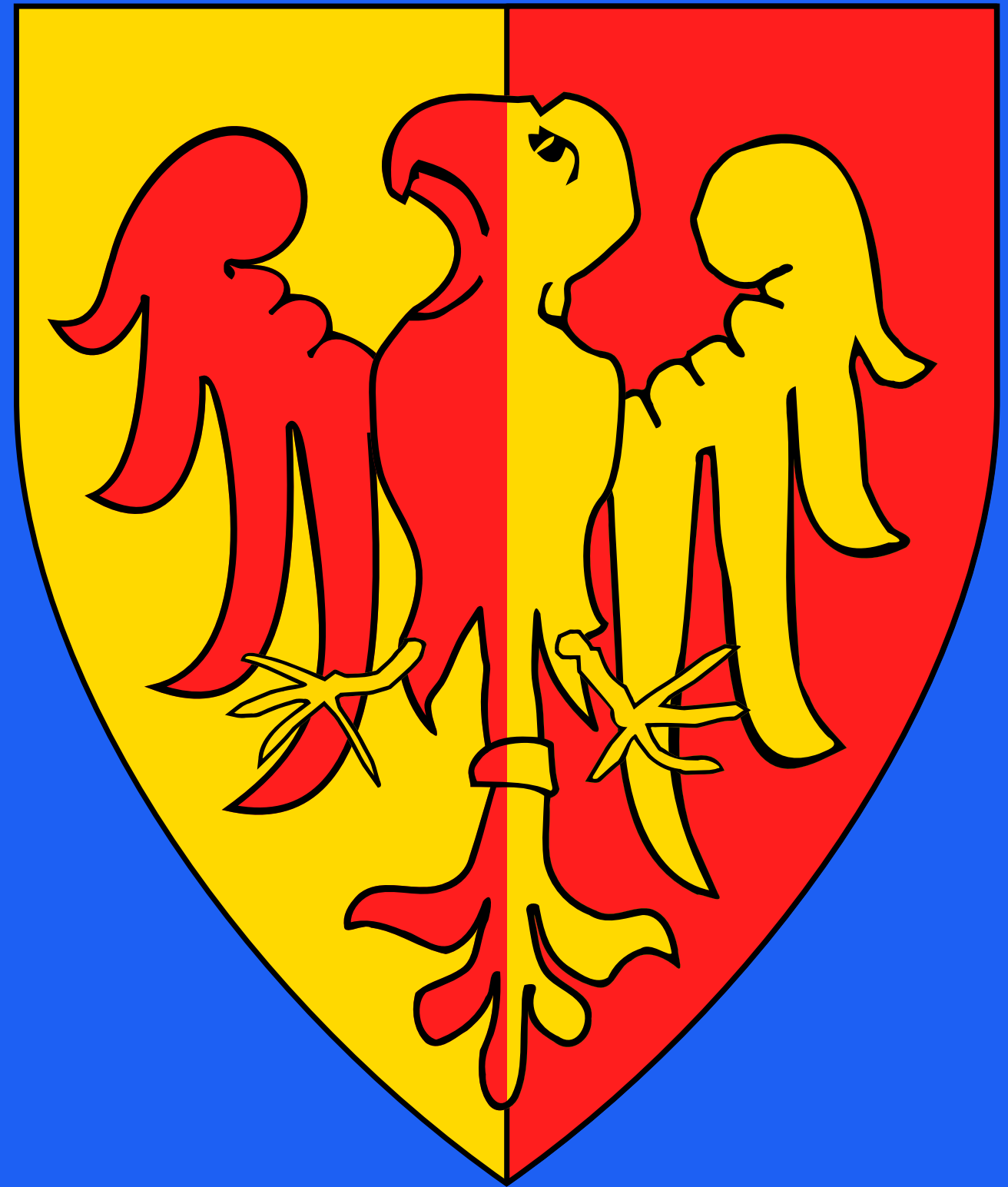

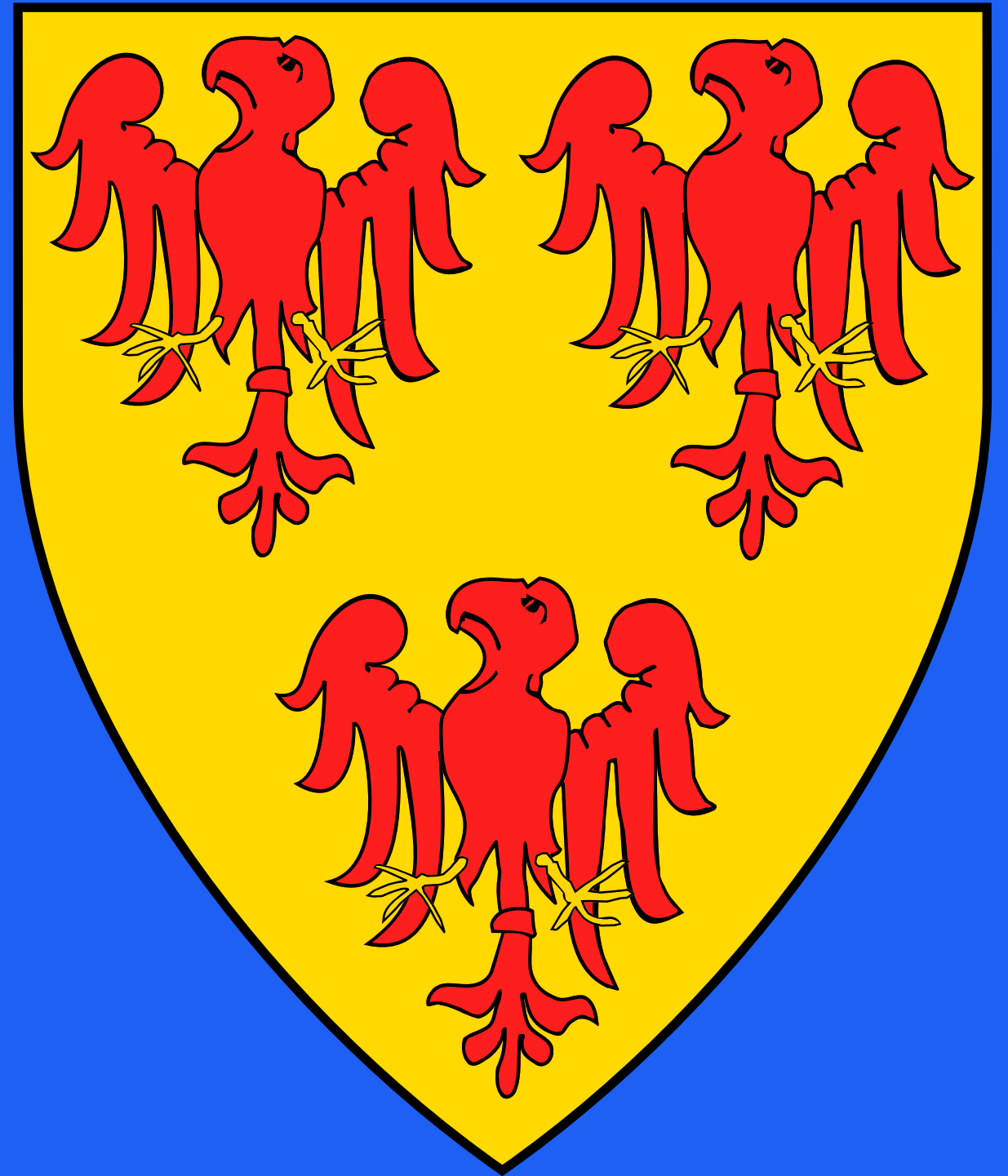

Vectorizing / converting a
bitmap image to an SVG

Path / Trace Bitmap



Easy with woodcuts, etchings

Harder with multicolour images

Very hard with worn, cracked,

“painterly” images.

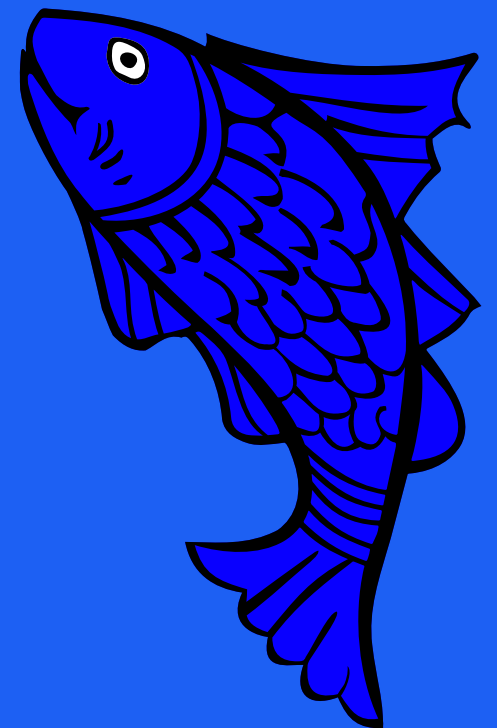

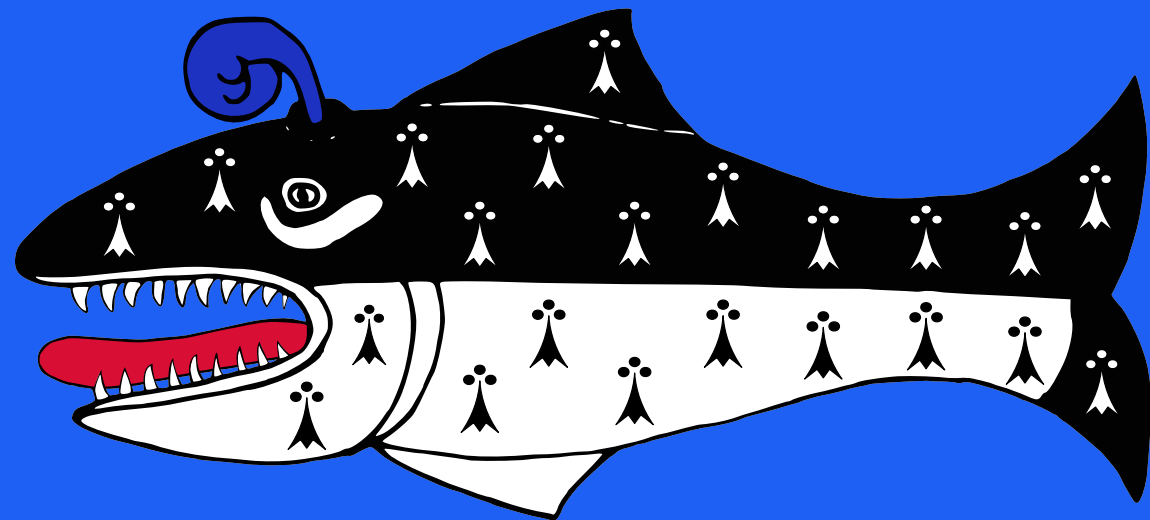

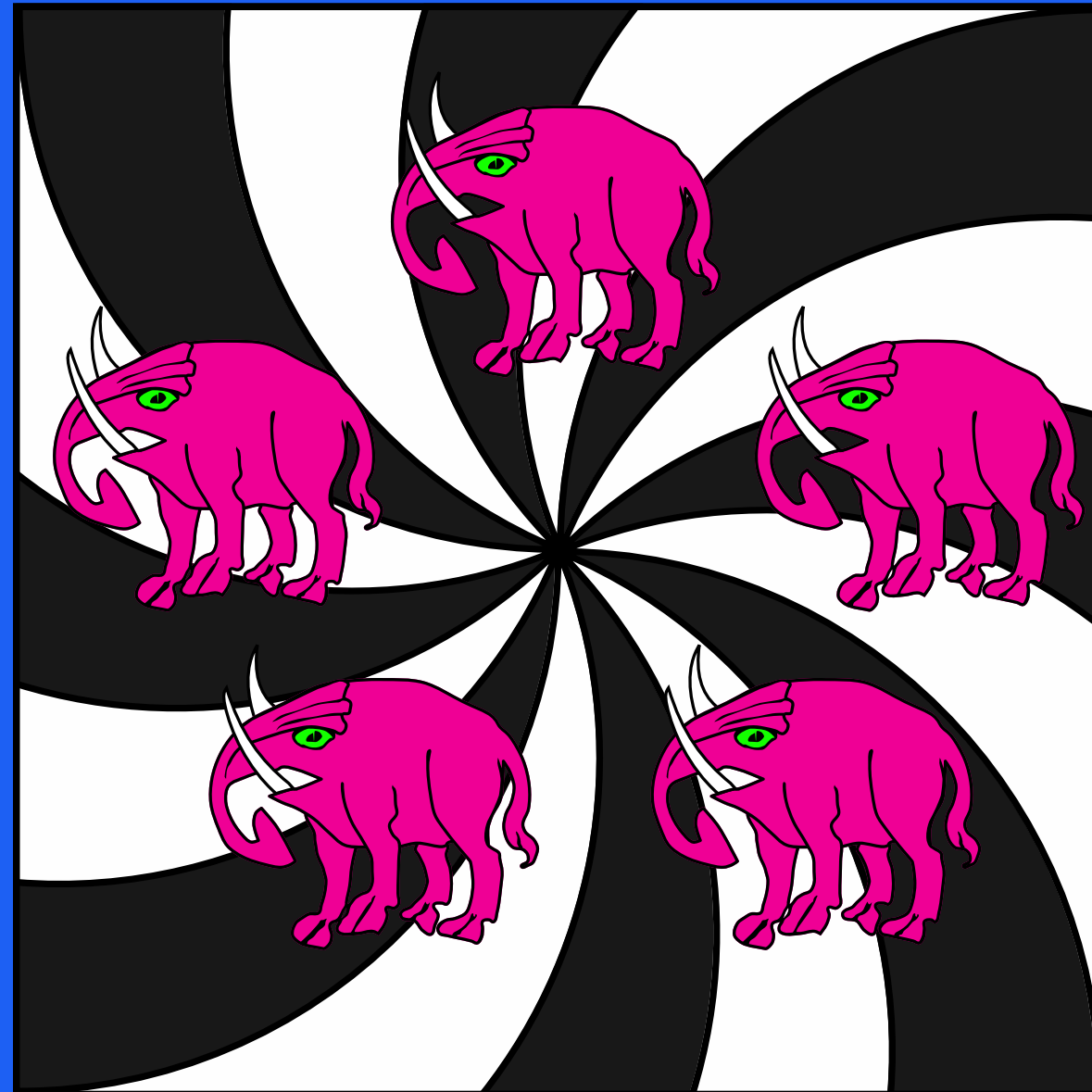
